Grant funds awarded to eligible COVID-19 impacted busi- nesses are to be used for eligible costs incurred between <u>either</u> March 1, 2020 and April 1, 2021 <u>pursuant to a small business recov- ery grant program as established under section 16-ff of the New York state urban development corporation act, or March 1, 2019 and Janu- ary 1, 2022 pursuant to a small business seed funding program as established under section 16-gg of the New York state urban develop- ment corporation act</u> related to operations, pandemic health and safety compliance, rental assistance, and other eligible costs as determined by the New York state urban development corporation. Funds appropriated herein shall also be used to provide outreach, technical assistance, and program administration directly attribut- able to the implementation and execution of this program.
