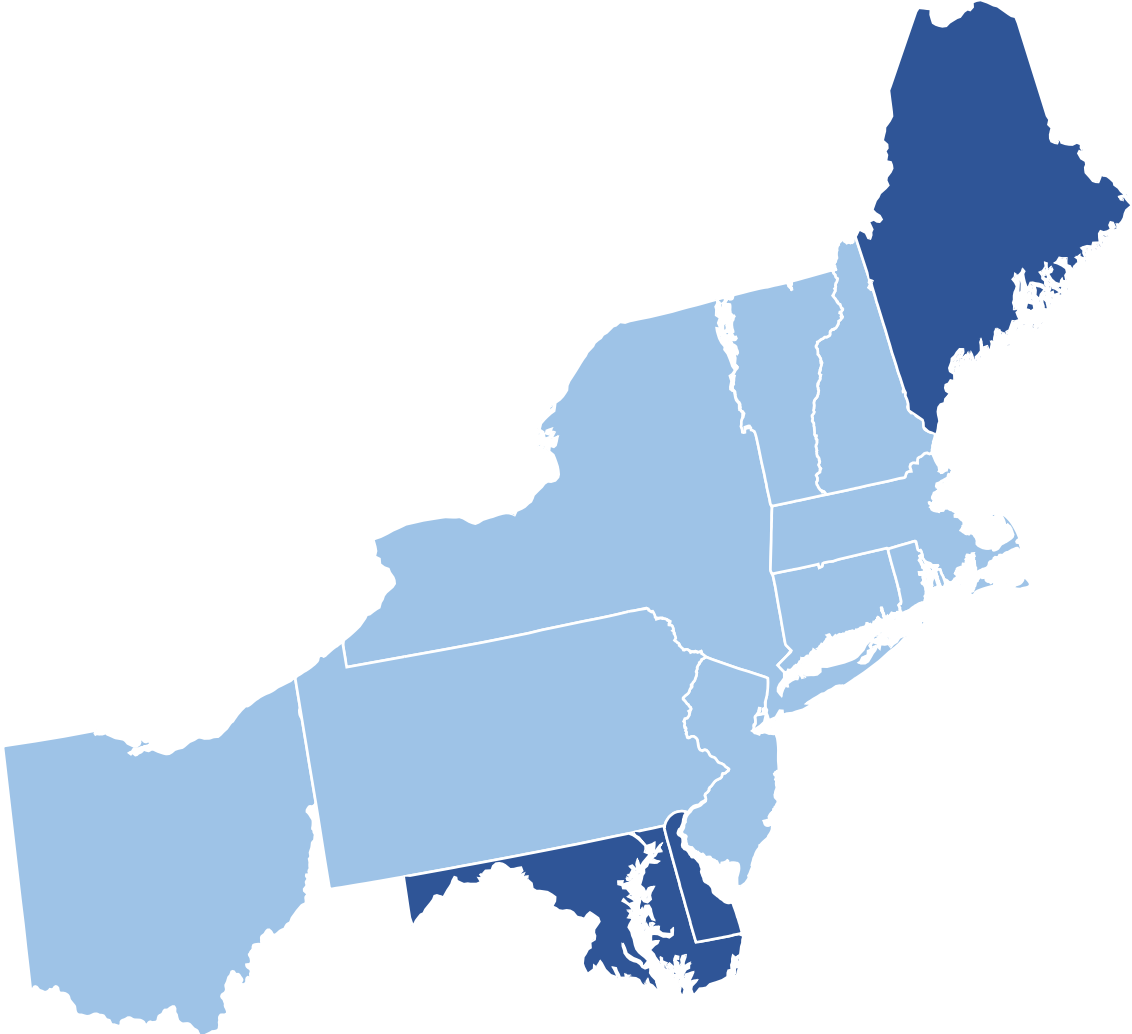

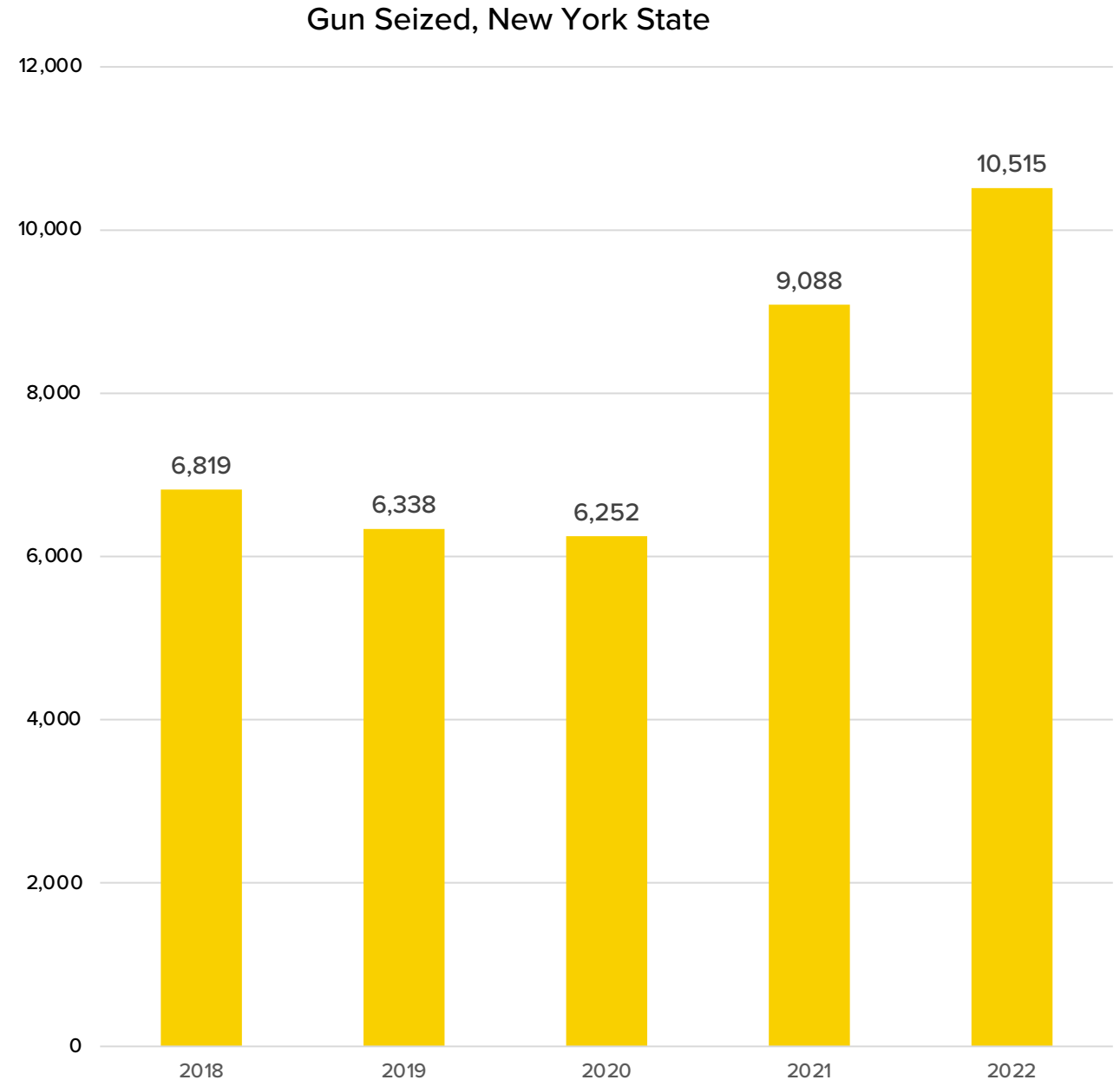

# Over 10,000 guns taken off the street in 2022

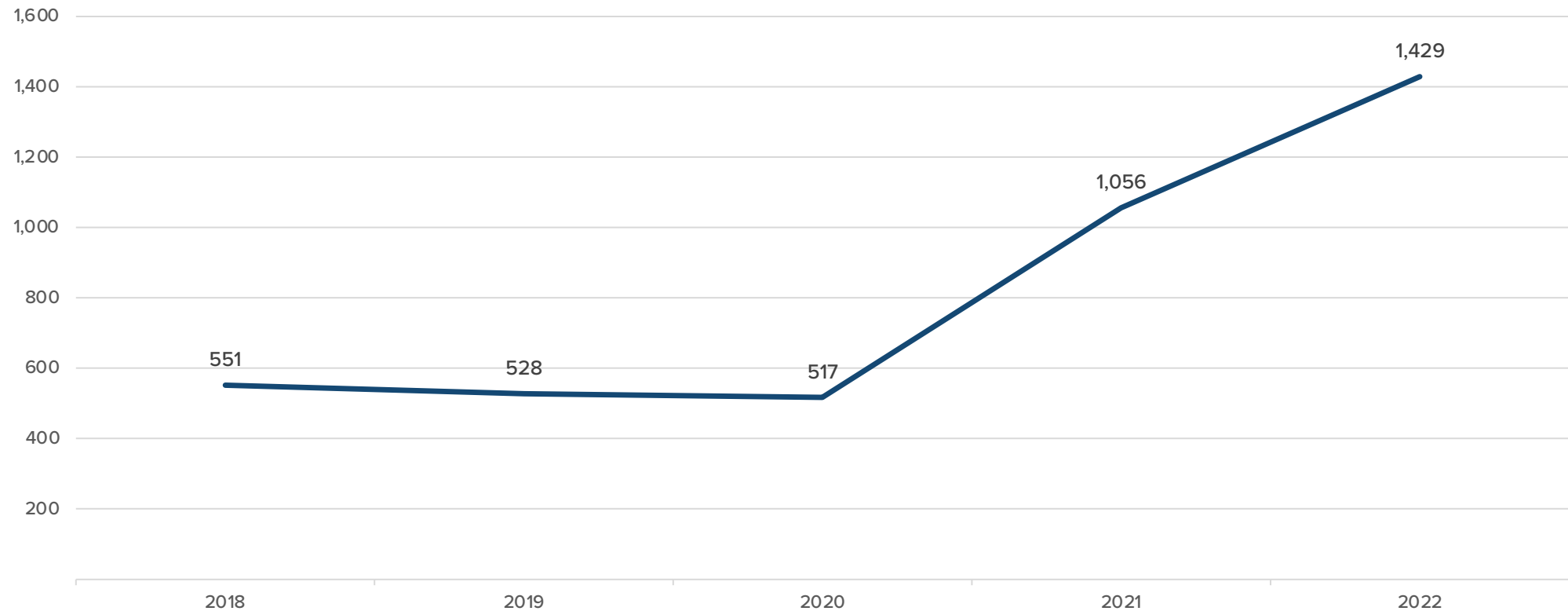
In 2022, police seized firearms at historic high numbers: **66% more** firearms seized than in 2019 and **16% more** firearms seized than in 2021





# THE TASK FORCE HAS REDEFINED THE ROLE OF THE STATE POLICE: IN 2022, THE STATE POLICE SEIZED A HISTORIC HIGH NUMBER OF GUNS

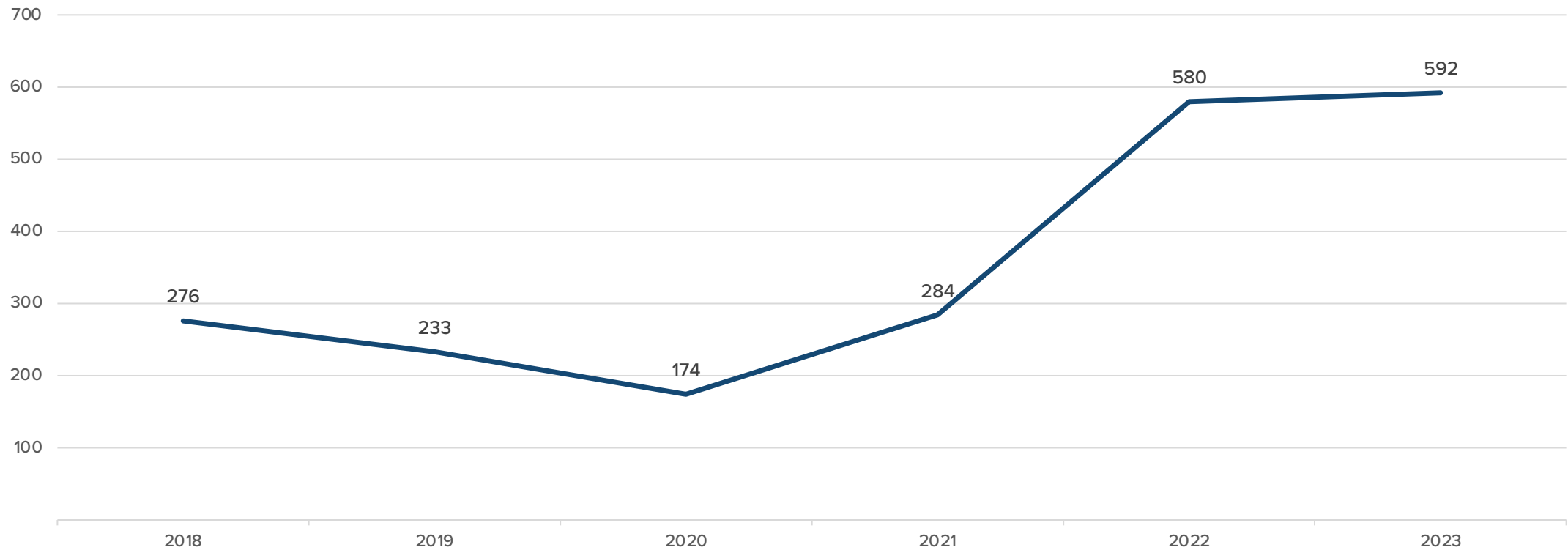
In 2022, New York State Police seized 35% more guns than in 2021

# IN 2023, THE STATE POLICE CONTINUES TO SEIZE MORE GUNS THAN EVER

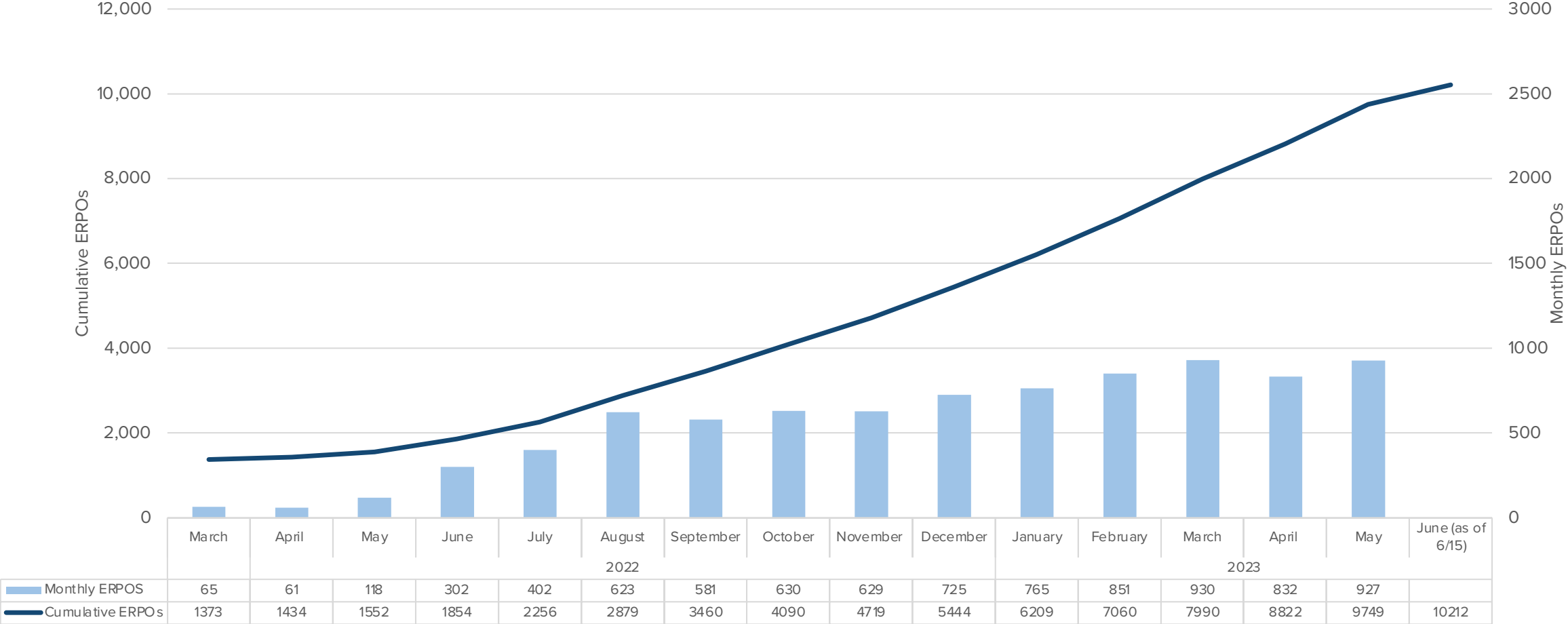
State Police seized 154% more firearms than in 2019 and 2% more than historic high 2022

# SINCE EXPANDING RED FLAG LAW, EXTREME RISK PROTECTION ORDERS UP OVER 600%

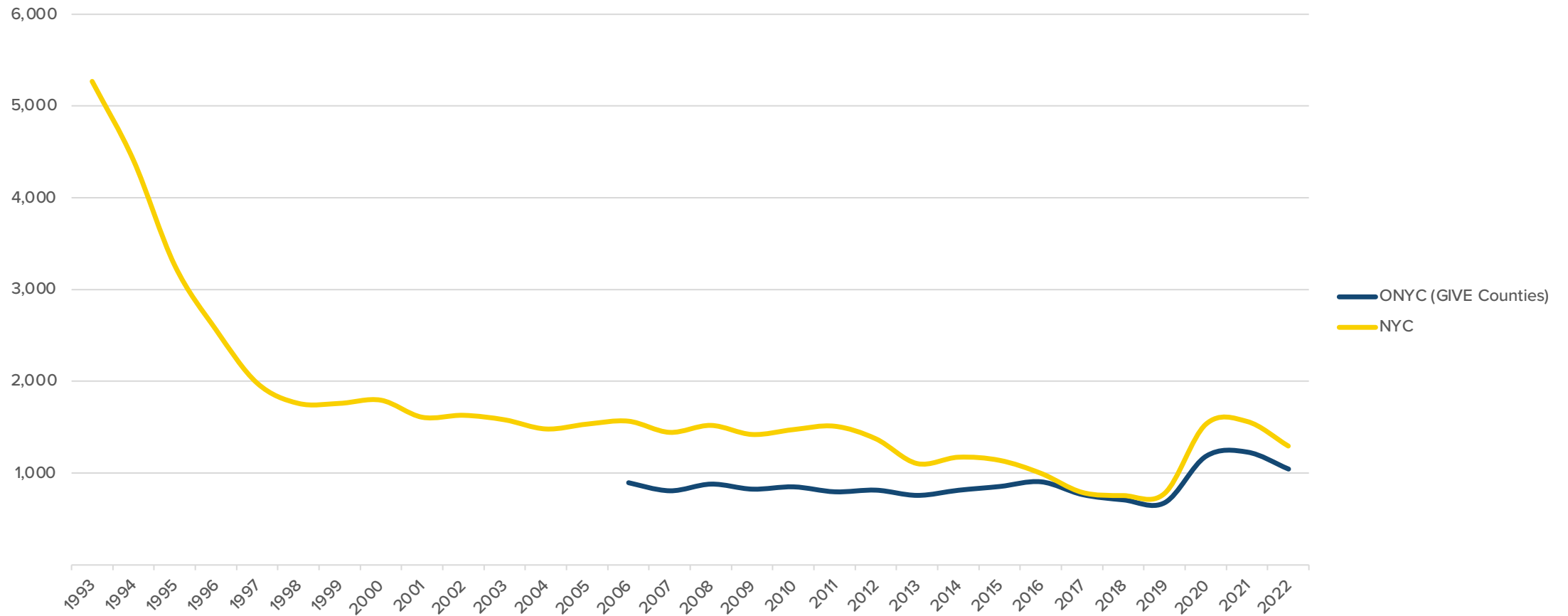
Extreme Risk Protection Orders by month





# FEWER GUNS ON THE STREETS, FEWER SHOOTING VICTIMS

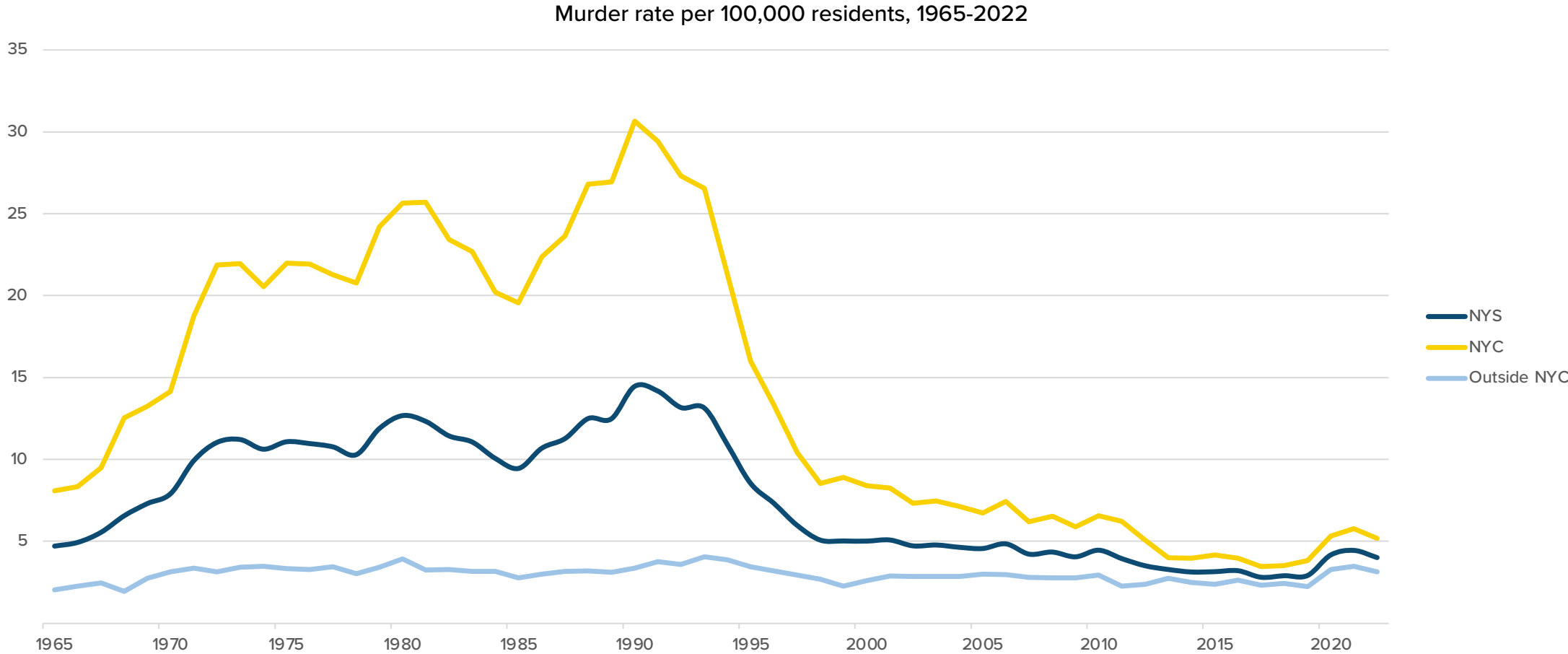
Shootings were down 15% in GIVE jurisdictions and 17% in NYC in 2022 vs 2021

# FEWER GUNS IN THE STREETS & FEWER SHOOTINGS, FEWER MURDERS

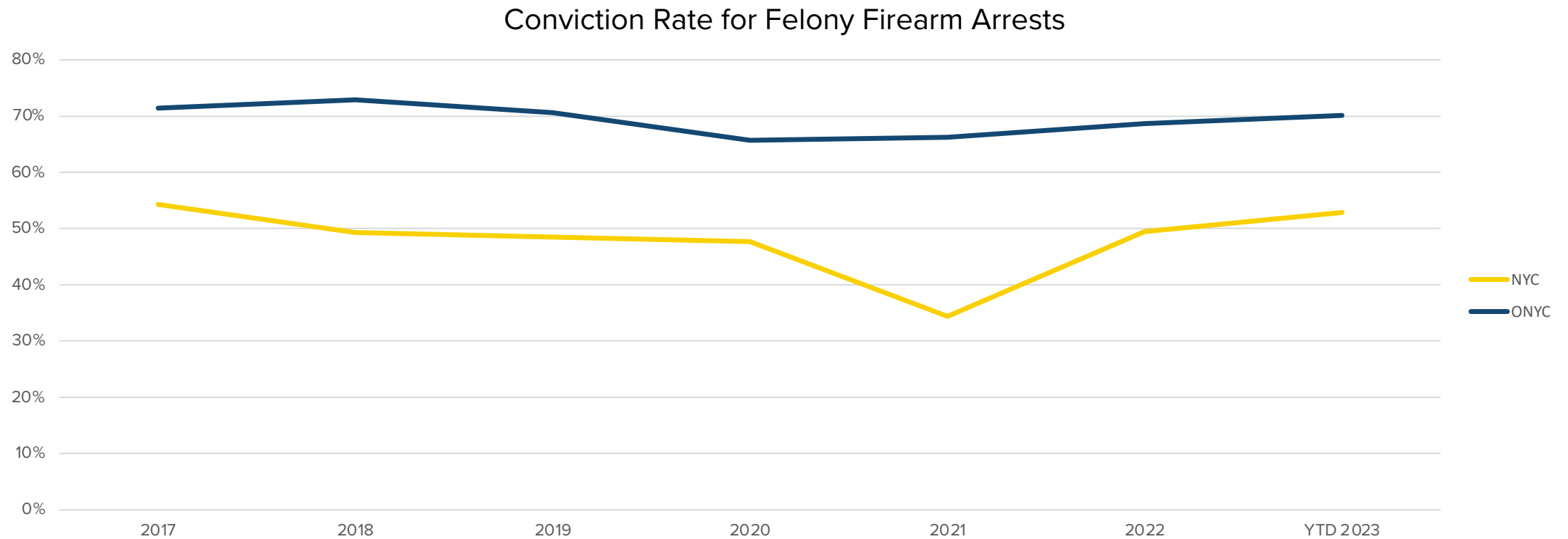
Murder rate decreased by over 10% in NYS and NYC in 2022, outpacing the national trend

# WITH INCREASED COOPERATION, MORE GUN ARRESTS & MORE PROSECUTIONS

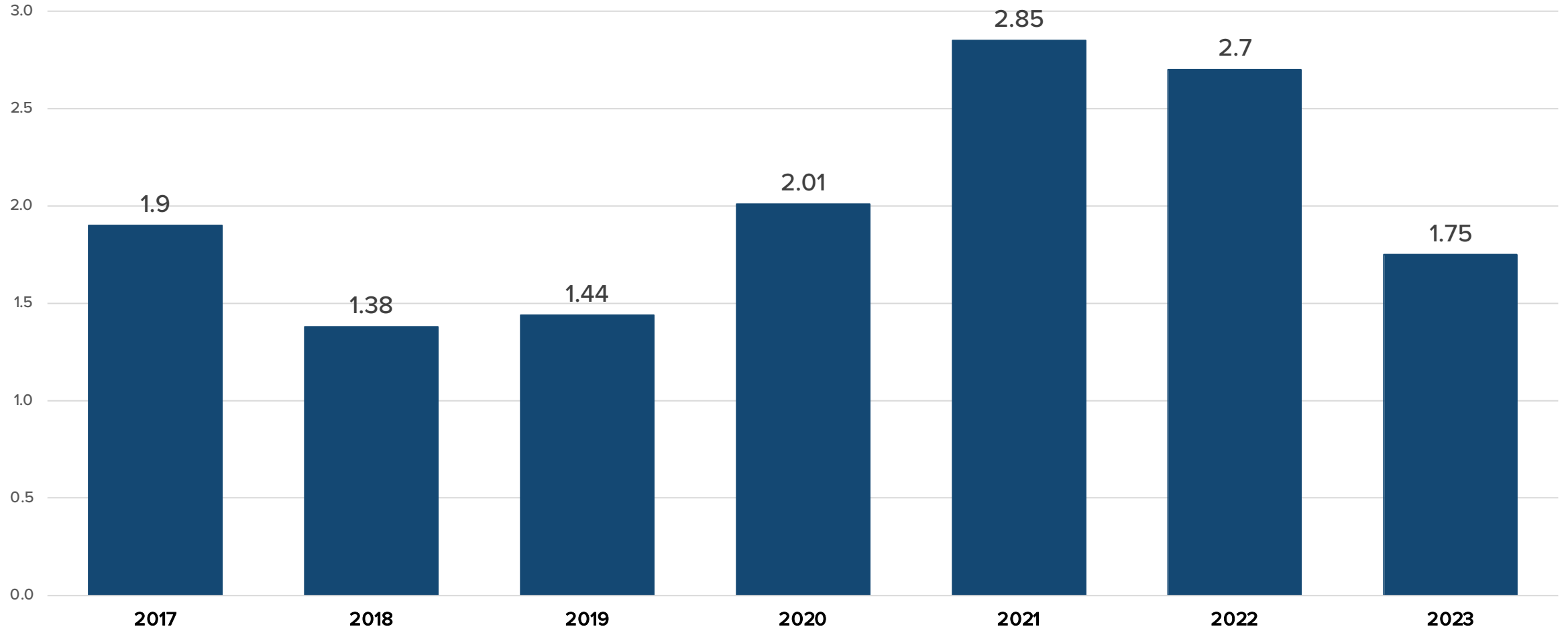
In 2022 & YTD 2023, conviction rate for felony firearm cases is on par with pre-pandemic

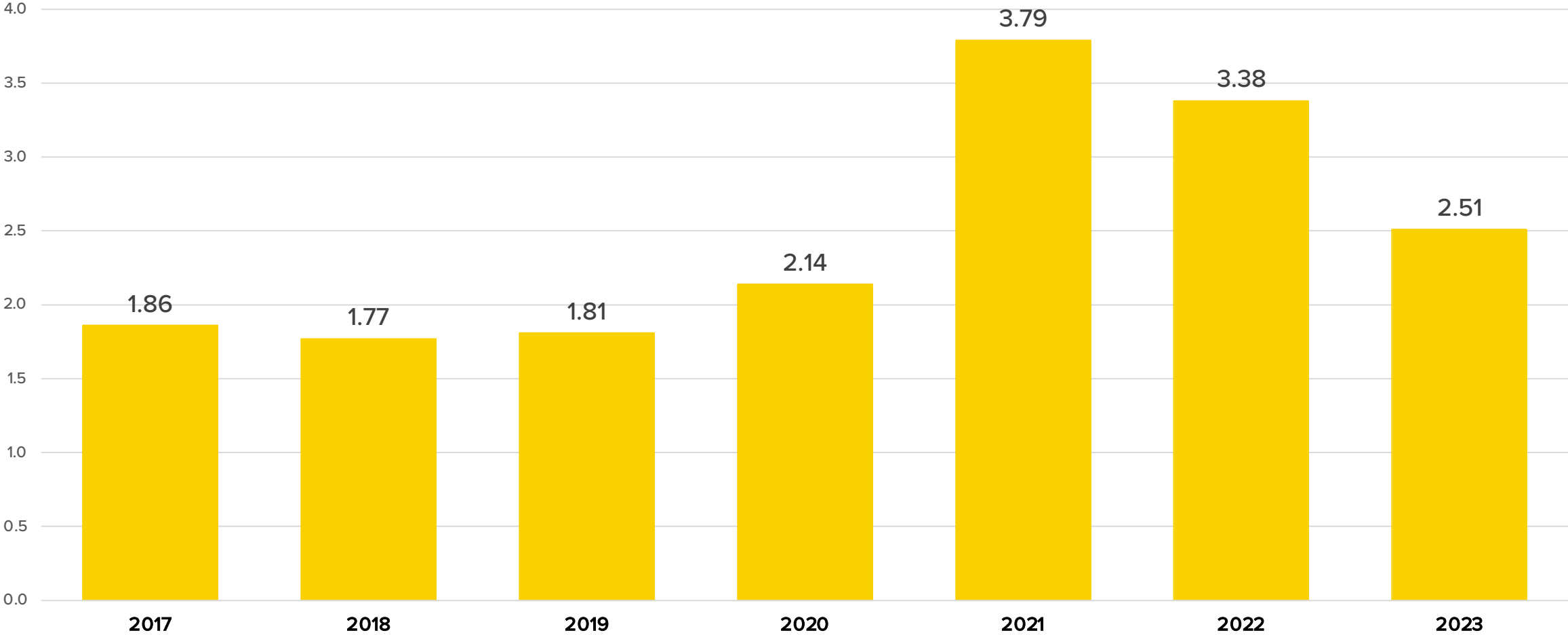
# OUTSIDE NEW YORK CITY, SHOOTINGS ARE SIMILAR TO PRE-PANDEMIC LEVELS

# \$337 MILLION TO REDUCE & PREVENT GUN VIOLENCE

- ✔ \$70 million to help communities respond to gun violence
- ✔ \$84 million for youth employment programs million for aid to prosecutors
- ✔ Over \$36 million for the Gun Involved Violence Elimination Initiative (GIVE)
- ✔ \$26 million to expand State Police Community Stabilization Units
- ✔ \$16 million for the statewide crime analysis network
- ✔ \$66.7 million to increase number of State Police Academy classes
