The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Legislative intent. The legislature hereby finds and
2 declares that the enactment of these appropriations provides sufficient
3 authority to the comptroller for the purpose of making payments for the
4 purposes described herein until such time as appropriation bills submit-
5 ted by the governor pursuant to article VII of the state constitution
6 for the support of government for the state fiscal year beginning April
7 1, 2024 are enacted.

8 § 2. Section 2 of chapter 111 of the laws of 2024, relating to making
9 appropriations for the support of government, as amended by chapter 114
10 of the laws of 2024, is amended to read as follows:

11 § 2. The amounts specified in this section, or so much thereof as
12 shall be sufficient to accomplish the purposes designated, is hereby
13 appropriated and authorized to be paid as hereinafter provided, to the
14 public officers and for the purpose specified, which amount shall be
15 available for the state fiscal year beginning April 1, 2024.

16 ALL STATE DEPARTMENTS AND AGENCIES

17 For the purpose of making payments for
18 personal service, including liabilities
19 incurred prior to April 1, 2024, on the
20 payrolls scheduled to be paid during the
21 period April 1 through April [11] 15, 2024
22 to state officers and employees of the
23 executive branch, including the governor,
24 lieutenant governor, comptroller, and
25 attorney general, and to employees of the
26 legislature. This appropriation also

1 includes funding for payment of health
 2 care and mental hygiene bonuses to eligi-
 3 ble state employees, and payments for
 4 services performed by mentally ill or
 5 developmentally disabled persons who are
 6 employed in state-operated special employ-
 7 ment, work-for-pay or sheltered workshop

10 § 3. Section 3 of chapter 111 of the laws of 2024, relating to making
 11 appropriations for the support of government, as amended by chapter 114
 12 of the laws of 2024, is amended to read as follows:

13 § 3. The amount specified in this section, or so much thereof as shall
 14 be sufficient to accomplish the purpose designated, is hereby appropri-
 15 ated and authorized to be paid as hereinafter provided, to the public
 16 officers and for the purpose specified, which amount shall be available
 17 for the state fiscal year beginning April 1, 2024.

18 ALL STATE DEPARTMENTS AND AGENCIES

19 For the payment of state operations non

 22 and the attorney general, and legislature,

2 legislature authorized the expenditure of
3 moneys during the 2023-2024 state fiscal
4 year; provided, however, that nothing
5 contained herein shall be deemed to limit
6 or restrict the power or authority of
7 state departments or agencies to conduct
8 their activities or operations in accord-
9 ance with existing law, and further
10 provided that nothing contained herein
11 shall be deemed to supersede, nullify or
12 modify the provisions of section 40 of the
13 state finance law prescribing when appro-
14 priations made for the 2023-2024 state
15 fiscal year shall have ceased to have
16 force and effect

6 § 8. No expenditure may be made from any appropriation in this act,
 7 until a certificate of approval has been issued by the director of the
 8 budget and a copy of such certificate shall have been filed with the
 9 state comptroller, the chairman of the senate finance committee and the
 10 chairman of the assembly ways and means committee provided, however,
 11 that any expenditures from any appropriation in this act made by the
 12 legislature or judiciary shall not require such certificate.

13 § 9. All expenditures and disbursements made against the appropri-
 14 ations in this act shall, upon final action by the legislature on appro-
 15 priation bills submitted by the governor pursuant to article VII of the
 16 state constitution for the support of government for the state fiscal
 17 year beginning April 1, 2024, be transferred by the comptroller as
 18 expenditures and disbursements to such appropriations for all state
 19 departments and agencies, as applicable, in amounts equal to the amounts
 20 charged against the appropriations in this act for each such department,
 21 agency, and the legislature and the judiciary.

22 § 10. Severability clause. If any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdi-
 23 vision, section or part of this act shall be adjudged by any court of
 24 competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect,
 25 impair, or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in

1 its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, section
2 or part thereof directly involved in the controversy in which such judg-
3 ment shall have been rendered. It is hereby declared to be the intent of
4 the legislature that this act would have been enacted even if such
5 invalid provisions had not been included herein.

6 § 11. This act shall take effect immediately and shall be deemed to
7 have been in full force and effect on and after April 1, 2024; provided,
8 however, that upon the transfer of expenditures and disbursements by the
9 comptroller as provided in section nine of this act, the appropriations
10 made by this act and subject to such section shall be deemed repealed.
