

Environmental Justice and Just Transition Working Group

The State is establishing an Environmental Justice Working Group that will include environmental justice and community leaders from across New York State, as well as health and labor advocates. The working group will provide recommendations to state agencies for the development of a statewide environmental justice policy and agency-specific environmental justice plans. The working group will also strategically target efforts to connect New Yorkers living in Environmental Justice communities with job opportunities created as part of Governor Cuomo's ambitious clean energy goals to generate 50 percent of the state's electricity from renewable sources by 2030.
