Under the Ryan replacement plan...

- Insurance premiums would skyrocket for the poor, elderly and those who need it most.
- Top 1% would pocket more than \$150 billion in tax breaks.
- A 64 year-old, living just above the poverty line, will see his/her premiums increase from \$1,700 under the ACA to \$14,600.

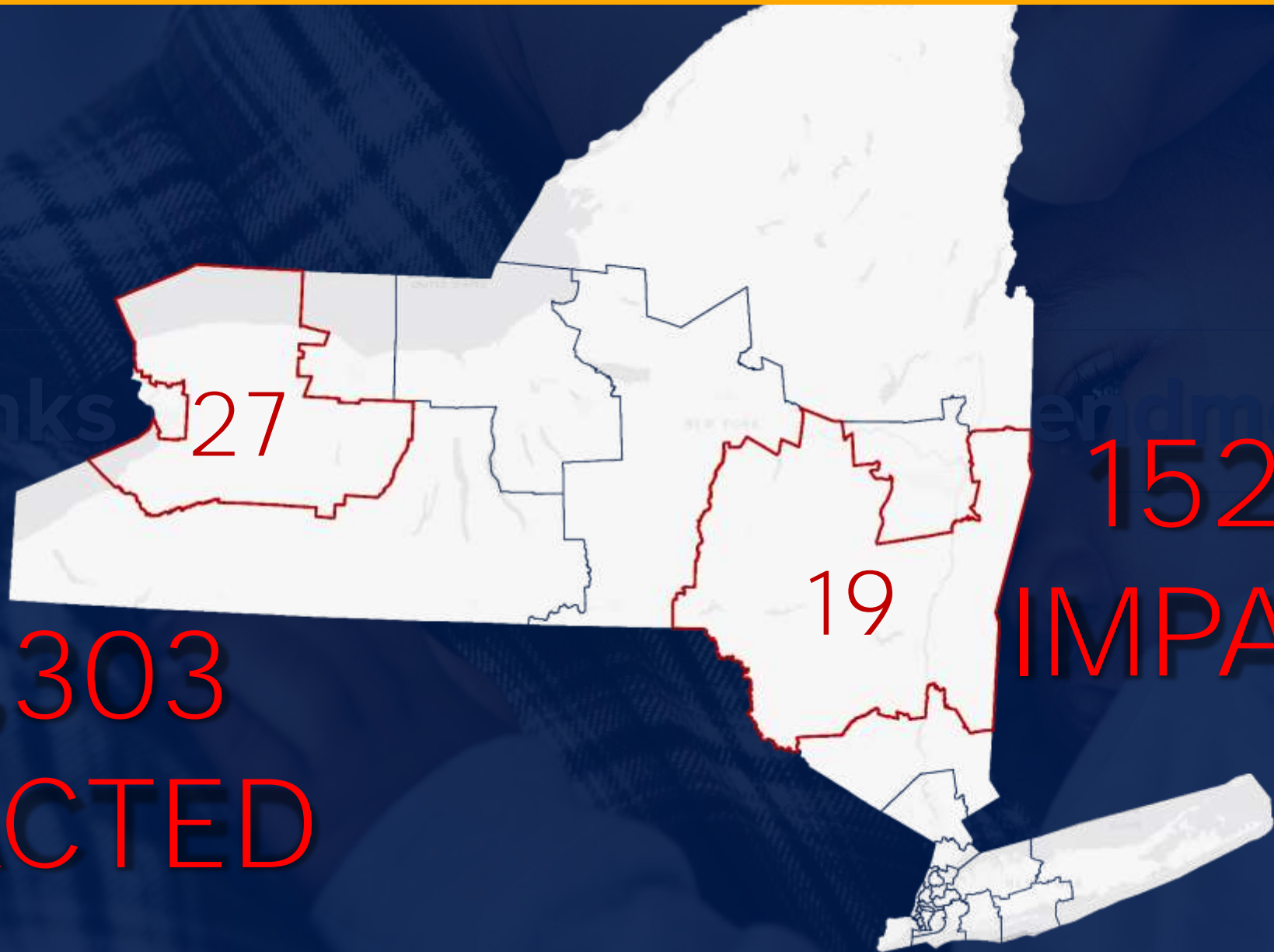

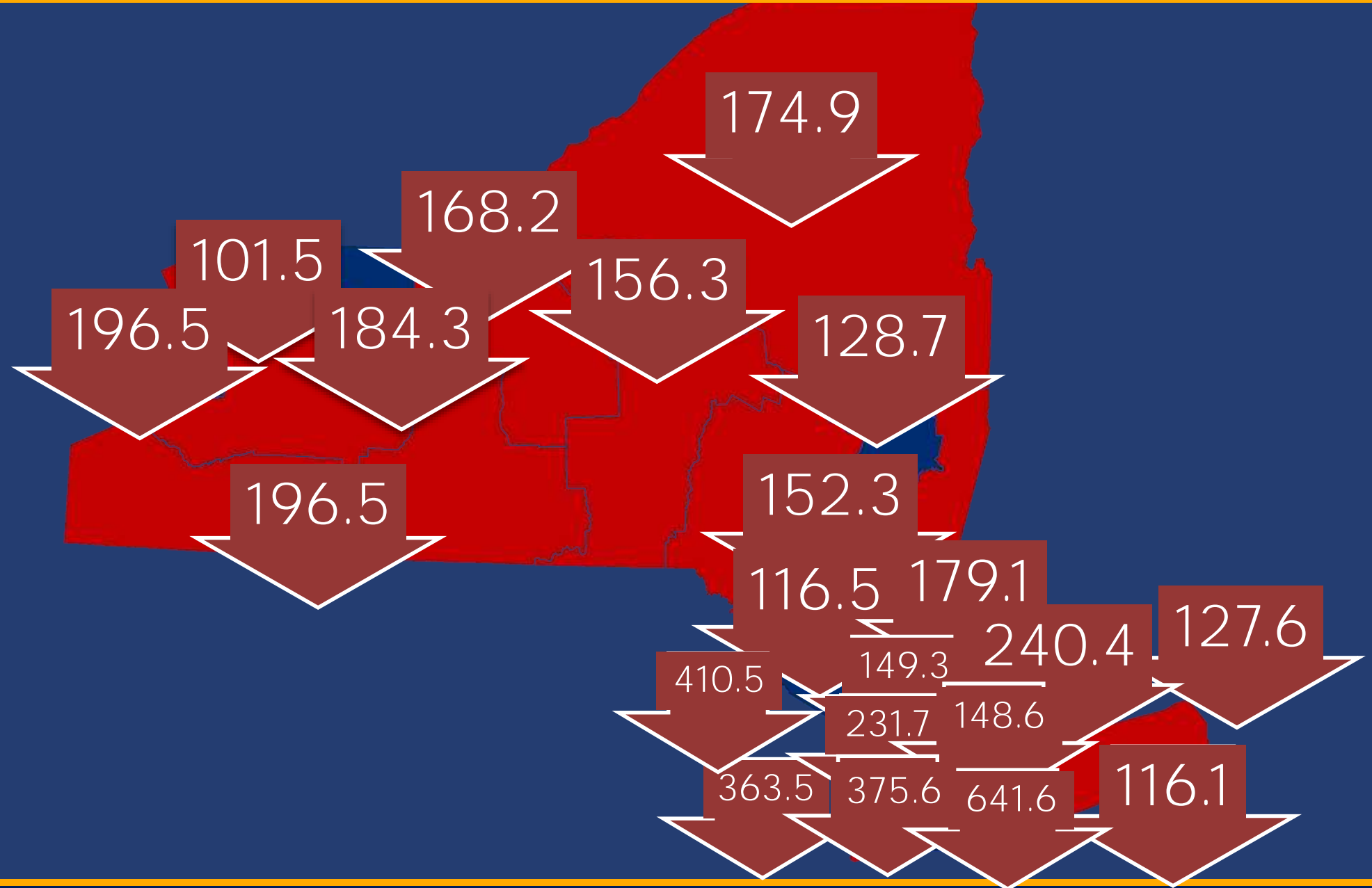
