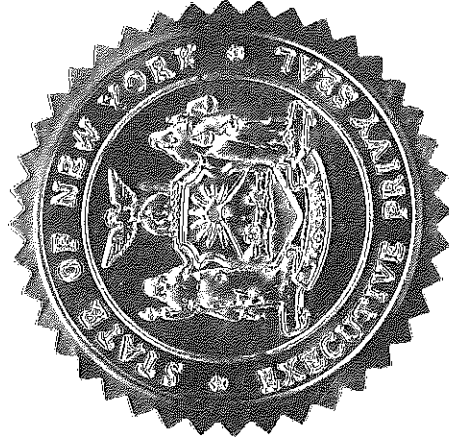

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, a vacancy exists in the office of Member of the United States House of Representatives from the eleventh Congressional District, including all or parts of Richmond and Kings counties, caused by the resignation of Michael Grimm;

WHEREAS, a vacancy exists in the office of Member of the Assembly of the State of New York from the forty-third Assembly District in Kings County, caused by the resignation of Karim Camara;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Andrew M. Cuomo, Governor of the State of New York, pursuant to Section 42 of the Public Officers Law, do hereby order and proclaim that an election for Member of the United States House of Representatives and Member of the Assembly of the State of New York in the place and for the unexpired terms of Michael Grimm and Karim Camara be held in the said Congressional and Assembly Districts on the fifth of May, two thousand fifteen, such elections to be conducted in the manner prescribed by law for election of Members of the United States House of Representatives and Members of the Assembly of the State of New York, respectively.
